Uniform Policy

As we head into the summer holidays, I am writing to ask for your continued support with students' school uniform.

Over the last couple of months, we have noticed a deterioration in the wearing of uniform. Whilst some students are adhering to the uniform policy as it is stated, we have seen an increase in numbers of students flouting the uniform expectations.

I have included in this ParentMail the uniform policy so that any confusion can be avoided for students returning to school in September.

I would like to point out that make up for years 10 and 11 should be discrete and that false nails, nail polish and false eyelashes are not permitted. Students will be asked to remove these should they attend school with them on.

Female students will also be expected to wear their skirts properly and not to roll them up. Skirts in the school shops now have two logos on them; one on the bottom of the skirt and one on the waist band. Both logos must be visible - the only exception to this is if a student is wearing a school jumper over her blouse, but the skirt must still not be rolled up. Girls will be able to continue to wear their existing school skirt but any replacements will need to have the two logos. When visiting Uniform Base or School Time you will only have the option to buy the new school skirt.

Adherence to the school rules is an expectation of attending Strood Academy and our high expectations of all matters relating to school ensure that students make good progress and enjoy their time whilst attending the Academy.

I would like to thank you in anticipation for your continued support.

This email will be sent again as a gentle reminder the week before we return.
