## Uniform policy

## OVERVIEW

We place a great deal of emphasis on the appearance of our students at Strood Academy. We expect them to be smart, well presented and to wear full uniform at all times.

Parents choose our academy because of our high standards. Therefore, we make no excuses in enforcing this policy to uphold the values we share with our parents and students in this area.

We have a strict uniform policy for the simple reason that it enables every child to attend the academy in an equal and fair way. By maintaining this expectation we ensure that appearance does not advantage or disadvantage any child based on fashion choice, socio-economic wealth or body shape/size.

We strongly believe that this basic equality is a fundamental right of children in education and that this is vital to a caring and safe learning environment.

## VALUE FOR MONEY

The academy believes that our uniform policy and suppliers should offer value for money and that the cost of uniform should never be a barrier to a child attending the academy. Therefore, the academy will ensure the following:

- Uniform costs and durability are balanced to ensure good value for money.
- The academy has a system for collecting and storing donated preloved uniforms which can be accessed by families who need this, free of charge.
- The academy will help families with financial assistance, where appropriate and as needed, when cost is a barrier to their child attending the academy and meeting our uniform expectations. This can be discussed and agreed on a case by case basis.
- The basic academy uniform only has very minimal branding and colour ranges to ensure that suitable alternatives can be found in high street stores whilst still meeting our expectations.
- One uniform is suitable for the whole year and no summer/ winter uniform is required.

- No coats are allowed to be worn in the school building and no hoods up on the academy site.
- Hoodies are banned from the site and will also be confiscated from students if worn.
- Students should only wear one pair of small gold or silver studded earrings to school.
- No facial piercings such as nose studs (including clear nose studs and retainers).
- No bracelets or necklaces allowed.
- No rings allowed.
- No trainers, boots, high heeled shoes, this includes black trainers or any shoe that the school judges to be a trainer.
- No sweatshirts or non-school jumpers are to be worn at any time.
- No knee length/ thigh length socks to be worn at any time.
- No leggings, skinny Jeans, denim trousers, chinos or non- school trousers.
- No baseball caps/ hats in the academy building
- No painted nails, false/acrylic nails.
- No false eyelashes or extensions.
- No white socks.
- No extreme haircuts e.g skin fades, graphics, lines and no shorter than a grade 1 (Senior leadership teams discretion).
- No shaving or slits in the eyebrows, they must be natural.
- No hair accessories allowed
- No fake tanSkirts must not be rolled up, and should be a suitable length around the knee.
- Make-up of any kind must not be worn by Years 7-9.
- Students are expected to be clean shaven.
- Uniform infringements will result in a 30 minute detention.
- If uniform cannot be rectified, this will result in pupils being placed within the Internal Engagement Room for the duration of the academy day and dismissed at 4:20pm. Students will continue to receive their class work on their chromebooks.

Note : Exemptions to a uniform policy are only necessary where an item is required to be worn as a compulsory requirement of the pupil's religion and this will be at the Principal's discretion. From September 2024, the academy will be implementing a gender neutral uniform. We will share this with you in January 2024 to ensure sufficient time to prepare.

Physical Education - The PE kit will be changing from September 2024, we will share this with you in January 2024(this will be a phased approach from September 2024).
